

Upon Arrival – Rules and Regulations

1. Competitors are obliged to observe and conform to the rules and regulations.
2. You shall not enter UKS Navigo Club area with trailers!!!!
3. Regatta office will be open 11th of August for preregistration (collecting badges, assigning place in catamaran parking).
4. Upon arrival at the regatta, competitors should go to the Parking P1 and walk to the UKS Navigo's regatta office to inform about the arrival and to collect World Championship badge and badges for the car, trailer, boat, beach trolley.
5. It is competitor responsibility to properly mark his equipment
6. Loading, unloading and assembling boats will be possible only in designated area in Parking P1.
7. Once boat is assembled it shall be transported directly to the catamaran parking place on the beach.
8. After unloading, trailers shall be transported to place designated by organizer it would be either Parking P1 or P2. Volunteers will assist you with transportation.
9. Cars shall be parked at Parking P1
10. Registration for Polish Nationals will be open on 14th of August
11. Registration for Worlds will be open on 19th of August.
12. Regatta organizer will provide participants with space at catamaran parking starting from 11th of August till 26th of August. Outside this period it is participants duty to arrange room for his equipment.
13. Identity band and identifiers shall be shown at each request of security officers or the Regatta Manager and his or her assistants.
14. All participants must follow the instructions of Regatta Manager and his or her assistants.
15. Cars, trailers must station at the places designated by the Organizer according to the map provided.
16. Catamarans must station in the designated catamaran park on the beach - according to the allocated ordinal number and available for inspection of the regatta.
17. The club area will not accommodate competitors' boats except for boats designated for measurement by the Measurer, and boats for repair, after obtaining the permission of the Regatta Manager.
18. Competitors are responsible for leftover items, equipment, and shall protect their belongings against damage and theft.
19. First-aid medical care will be available during regatta.
20. Accompanying persons may move around the event area only after registering at the Regatta Office and receiving an identification band.
21. All competitors and accompanying persons are obliged to keep the area clean. Empty bottles and all waste should be disposed of in waste containers located in the event area.
22. Before entering the club buildings, toilets, tents participants are asked to rinse feet or shoes from sand.
23. It is prohibited to rinse boats and other equipment in the yard or in the UKS Navigo club . (Please note that water in Gdańsk Bay is only marginally salty so there is no need to rinse boat after sailing.)
24. The competitors are responsible for safe launching boats and returning to the beach. Launching and returning shall be done in the designated area and with special attention.
25. When maneuvering the boat on the beach competitors shall consider passers-by and other participants of the regatta, and for the equipment remaining on the beach.
26. Each boat must be attached to the ground to prevent it from rolling over.
27. From 20.00 to 07.00, competitors are prohibited from entering the catamaran park on the beach.
28. For safety reasons, competitors shall never sail alone.
